WHAT: Keystone is BGCA's premier teen leadership program. Founded in 1964, Keystoning meets teens' vitally important needs for positive group experiences. With the guidance of Club staff, opportunities are provided for teens to make leadership decisions, engage in academic and career experiences and serve others.

Annual Panther Keystone Events:

<u>Parents Night Out:</u> The event runs one Friday every month from 6-10pm. Keystoners attend and help supervise and run the event. All proceeds go directly to Keystone.

<u>National Project:</u> Our Keystone club organizes and works on a National Project each year. The National Keystone Club introduces a new topic each year. These projects promote awareness and assistance in issues facing teens today. We have worked on topics such as: Teens LEAD, Hope for the Homeless, After the Cameras Leave and Teen Suicide.

<u>Grains of Hope:</u> For the past few year's our Keystone Club has been a partner organization in Grains Of Hope. This project is held in Pequannock and has raised of \$50,000 to purchase and package meals for Haiti and the NJ Food Bank. Keystone not only assists in the fundraising and planning of this event but also serves as leaders during the packaging event.

<u>Family Week</u>: Each year Keystone organizes an event for National Family Week.

<u>Frosty's Friends:</u> The teens coordinate a holiday gift drive as well as a dinner for our local families in need during the holiday season.

We Own Friday: The teens organize monthly outings as a part of Teen Outreach to engage other teens in the community for a fun night out.
