



PROGRAMS THAT WORK

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Northwest New Jersey's programs promote education, healthy living, character development and good citizenship. Our organization provides outcome-driven experiences that help young people reach their full potential, particularly those who need us most.

We serve 5,200 youth annually through our various programs. We operate two physical facilities—the Wayne Unit located at 153 Garside Avenue and home

to our administrative offices and the Pequannock Unit located at 19 Oak Avenue. We also provide after-care to students in several communities in their local schools.

Programs Include:

Care of Children from 6 weeks to Grade 8

Early Education Center (Wayne Location): Our Early Education program offers age-appropriate activities for children ages 6 weeks to 5 years old to prepare them for a successful start in kindergarten. Teachers keep children actively engaged in educational, social and physical activities that include technology, science, math, music, phonics, social studies, arts and crafts, reading, dramatic play, and indoor and outdoor play in our gym and on our playground. We provide children the opportunity to grow and learn in a fun, safe and caring environment.

Kindergarten Program: Our Kindergarten



Program provides participants the opportunity to grow and develop in a fun and educational setting. Activities, which take place in a dedicated area in the Wayne building, include arts and crafts, educational activities, sports, game room, technology, music, homework help and more.

In addition, the clubs provide transportation from local elementary schools.

<u>After-School Program</u>: The After-School Program provides a safe environment with professional staff to meet the needs of children from kindergarten to Grade 8. Daily activities include homework help, arts and crafts, game room time, sports and the technology center. We also offer Boys & Girls Club of America national programs such as Smart Moves and Power Hour. Transportation is provided for children from local elementary and middle schools to our Club locations or held in the school children attend.

<u>Summer Day Camp</u>: Our weekly summer camp provides families with a safe place for their youngsters during off-school summer days. Camp includes themed weeks and supervised activities such as swimming, games, sports challenges, arts and crafts, weekly field trips, and SMART Moves components.

<u>Vacation Club</u>: Vacation Club is offered to members during scheduled days off during the school year. This program is designed to engage youngsters in supervised activities during school breaks including games, activities, computer access, arts and crafts, and more.

We also offer enrichment in the following areas in our Kindergarten, After-School, Summer Camp and Vacation Club Programs:

- Computer Learning Center: Our technology centers provide children access to educational software, games, homework completion, and the Internet in an adult-supervised environment.
- SMART Moves: Young people need peer support and viable solutions that enhance their life skills, build their resiliency, improve their health, and strengthen their leadership skills. Participants are exposed to activities designed to hone their decision-making and critical thinking skills, as well as learn how to avoid and/or resist alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs.
- Power Hour: An after-school program that helps club members ages 6-12 be more successful in school by providing homework help and encourages members to



become self-directed learners. Assistants offer to teach members how to reference materials, conduct research, and check assignments for completion and accuracy.

• Game Room: Access to recreational games such as billiards, foosball, ping pong, and board games.

Sports and Fitness

Recreational Sports Leagues: These recreational programs provide the opportunity for all youngsters to learn and enjoy playing organized sports without the stress of a competitive environment. Participants are assigned a team and rules are designed to guarantee participation. The Clubs' code of conduct guides players, coaches, and spectators to keep these programs on a recreational



basis and promote fun in each sport to instill lifelong participation.

<u>Travel Teams</u>: Sports teams provide a more competitive environment for participants to practice and enhance their sport-specific skills. Teams meet for weekly practice sessions with certified volunteer coaches and compete in challenging games. Through participation, youth learn sportsmanship, teamwork, and skill

development. These programs also include social and recreational activities so that members can have fun while acquiring self-confidence and building interpersonal relationship skills.

<u>Clinics</u>: These programs teach young children the simple rules of sports, encourage participation, and promote teamwork and physical activity. Clinics include softball, field hockey, soccer, volleyball, football, and basketball

<u>Preschool Sports Program</u>: Provides preschoolers with activities that promote socialization, gross motor skills, concentration, problem solving, and sportsmanship, while introducing and developing sport-specific skills.



Leadership Development


<u>Torch Club</u>: Torch Club is a chartered small-group leadership and service club of youth ages 11-13. Torch Club is a powerful vehicle through which staff can help meet the special needs of younger adolescents at a critical stage in their development. Members learn to elect officers and work together to plan and implement activities in four areas: service to Club and community, education, health and fitness, and social recreation.

Keystone Club: Keystone Club is a chartered leadership and service club for young people ages 14-18. Keystone members elect officers and plan and implement their own activities



in six areas: service to the Club and community, leadership development, education and career exploration, unity, free enterprise and social recreation.

<u>Youth of the Year:</u> The premier youth recognition program for Club members ages 14-18 promotes and celebrates their service to the Club, community and family; academic performance; spiritual values; life goals; and poise and public speaking ability. BGCNWNJ selects a Youth of the Year who then participates in state, regional and national competition levels.
